Immigrant Grandparents on the Go for immigrant grandparents and their grandchildren (0 – 5 years old). Our Settlement Worker provides a program for grandparents to learn about Canadian culture, practice English and make connections in their new community. The children learn new skills while having fun in the playroom. Fridays from 12:15 – 2:20 pm in the community room at the Royal City Centre Mall (located at 6th Street & 6th Avenue). **This program will be closed in July & August.** Funded by the United Way of the Lower Mainland.
