Parent Education Classes

Childminding is provided. Please arrive promptly at 9:30 to settle your children in the playroom.

May 4th Parenting in Canada Part 1 & 2: Parenting in your home country may be quite different from parenting & 11th Canada. Learn what is expected of parents in Canadian culture. It is recommended to attend both sessions.

May 18th Choosing Suitable Daycare: Find out what to look for and what questions to ask before you leave your child in the care of others.

May 25th Family Yoga: Stretch, breathe and relax with a certified yoga instructor. Children will participate with their parents.
